

## **Air Jordan 8 'Turbo Green'**

For decades, the Air Jordan 8 has been among the most popular shoes the Jordan brand has to offer. The sneaker was first released in 1993, and Michael Jordan himself wore a pair before his first retirement from the game (after winning his seventh title and leading the Chicago Bulls go yet another victory). The Air Jordan 8 has never seen a plunge in popularity, and now it has been announced that the sneaker will be released in a new design option later this year.

The new design is sure to excite both newer and longtime fans of the shoe. It's retaining the famous crossover straps and stylish high top look, but of course is coming with some newer features that are a combination of modern 2010s fashion and retro 90s cool. Currently slated for release on October 13 on Nike.com and other select retailers of the Jordan brand, this latest edition of the popular sneaker comes with perforated side detailing and a new color scheme. True to its name, the Air Jordan 8 Turbo Green comes with bright green ("turbo" green) accents in conjunction with pure white. The shoe also features white leather across the upper. As of right now, the projected retail price will be \$190.
